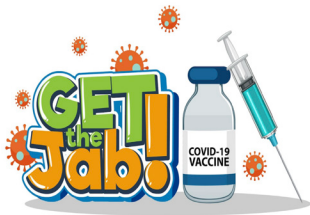
Calling fitness groups.

FLU AND COVID-19 BOOSTERS



In addition to the existing winter flu program for those over 65, on 15 July the government announced that free winter flu jabs would be extended to all those over the age of 50 and also those school children in years 7,8 and 9, under plans to increase protection over the winter period. For these new groups the jab can now be booked online for any date from 15th October. Boots and Lloyd pharmacies can be booked on-line, as well as booking through the local gp. In addition those aged over 50 and other eligible groups will be offered the Covid-19 booster.
