A small number of Neighbourhood Watch signs have now been added in the village.

PLANNING APPLICATIONS

Local Planning Applications that we have been notified of which may be of interest include:

NE/22/00698/OUT in respect to additional warehousing off the A605 near Thrapston and Titchmarsh. Comments are due in by 1 July. This is in additional to the warehousing planning application that went in earlier this year.

NE/22/00665/FUL in respect to demolition of an exisiting conservatory and erection of a ground floor rear extension, and loft conversion with proposed front and rear dormers at Craigmarr, Main Street.
