18/06/112	<p>To consider BWPC response to a request to financially support the Call Connect bus service</p> <p>Cllr Shacklock requested that BWPC give consideration to pledging £300 to help support the Call Connect Service until the end of this financial year if sufficient support can be obtained from other communities covered by the service. After discussion it was resolved to pledge the requested amount.</p> <p>Resolved: To pledge £300 to support Call Connect until the end of March 2019. Clerk to contact County Cllr W Brackenbury and let her know BWPCs decision.</p>
18/06/112a	<p>Additional business not on Agenda – for report only</p> <p>Cllr Shacklock updated the council on the matter of Oundle North Bridge needing to be restricted to a 3 ton weight limit until structural repairs could be carried out which may take up to 2 or more years due to funding issues. Traffic over this limit will need to access Oundle via the road from Corby or by the South Bridge where the existing weight limit would be raised whilst the North Bridge restriction is in place. Concerns about traffic safety for vehicles using the A605 junction will need to be addressed.</p> <p>Resolved: Report only – no action needed</p>
