5	Questions from the floor Several issues raised by member of the public 1) Thanks from a resident for the work that the PC carries out. 2) Query on a planning application the PC had made objections to. 3) Concerns about weight of vehicles using the village bridge and a request that the PC approach highways to discuss this issue. 4) Question as to when the mobile telecoms mast would be installed and concerns over proposed plans by BT to move to a digital system when the mobile phone signal is poor. 5) Questions over public transport links or the lack of. An offer was made for a 7 seater vehicle to be made available for a period of time if it was feasible to set up a volunteer community transport scheme. 6) Request for planters to be installed at entrance to the village. It was thought that it would be better if this was organised by a different organisation from the PC but it may be possible once the village gates/speed calming measures were installed 7) Concerns over the condition some dogs are being kept in. This is beyond the remit of the PC which has no legal power to intervene, and residents will need to take their concerns to the appropriate authority.
