1. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Vicky Hinstridge, John Homersley, Shirley Hughes, Karen Jones and Robert Sheppard.

2. <u>To receive and determine a quotation for the modification (insertion of a window) to the bus shelter located on the A494 opposite to the Village Centre.</u>

Before presenting the quotation for the improvement work to the bus shelter to the Council the Clerk requested Councillor Carl Jackson to sign the Notice of Disclosed Interest; Councillor Jackson complied with the request then declared a prejudicial interest and temporarily left the meeting.

The Members fully considered the submitted quotation received from CMS, Clwyd Multi-Services and resolved to accept the said quotation of £400 for the bus shelter improvements. Councillor Jackson then returned to the meeting.

3. Planning Matters

Ref: ADW/051490, Erection of 8 dwellings on the site of the former Rainbow Inn public house including the conversion of the existing building to form 2 dwellings, located at Ruthin Road, Gwernymynydd.

Councillor Marjorie Thomson outlined the planning proposal, drawing reference to an application which had previously been approved by Flintshire County Council's Planning Department; this present application being an extension of the previous submission.
