Whilst there are no objections to the felling of the trees, there are questions regarding replanting of replacement trees, especially considering that in 2017 they felled 21 trees. The Community Council feels a programme of replanting needs to be put in place and suggests 4 new trees be planted for every1 that is felled. These recommendations will be put to the planning department.
