The Community Association is certain that all residents will be pleased to learn that thanks to the persistent efforts of the Association and yourselves, the Welsh Office has agreed to provide a pelican crossing as part of the Trunk Road improvement scheme and will be considering the best location for this in the vicinity of the school.

The possibility of putting in a central island refuge is also being looked into, dependent upon the space available.

At this stage the Welsh Office is not proposing to make any change in the present 40 mph speed restriction through the village. However, they do propose to keep the situation under close review once traffic is using the improved stretch of the road and seek the views of the Police Authority before making any decisions as to whether a change should be made.

Nevertheless, the concessions provided as above and the speed with which they have been decided upon surely demonstrate to us as local people the concern of the Welsh Office for our safety and well-being.
