Due to lateness of crop on the usual field the site of the Show has been changed to:

KENDRICK'S FIELD, RUTHIN ROAD, NOLD.

(next to Recreation Ground, site of Carnival Horse Show)

Arrangements are now completed for the Show on Saturday, July 18th. Attractions include the Horse Show and Gymkhana, Exemption Dog Show, Buckley Art Society Exhibition, Wellie Throwing, Football Goal Kick Competition, Bran Tub, Tarzan Swing, Tombola, Cake Stall, Fruit Stall, Ices, Sweets, Usual Refreshments in Marquee, Children's Fancy Dress Competitions - Under-5, Over-5 and Groups.

The event will begin at 9-30 am and the Mayor and Mayoress of Delyn, Councillor and Mrs. E. Price Whitley arrive at 2 pm approx. after which the Fancy Dress and Competitions will take place.

Gwernymynydd School are also holding Gwernymynydd Royal Sports Day at the Show. This will follow the Fancy Dress Competitions. There will be events for children aged up to 12.
