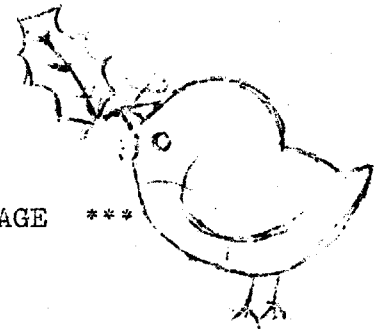

** MONDAY 21st DECEMBER **



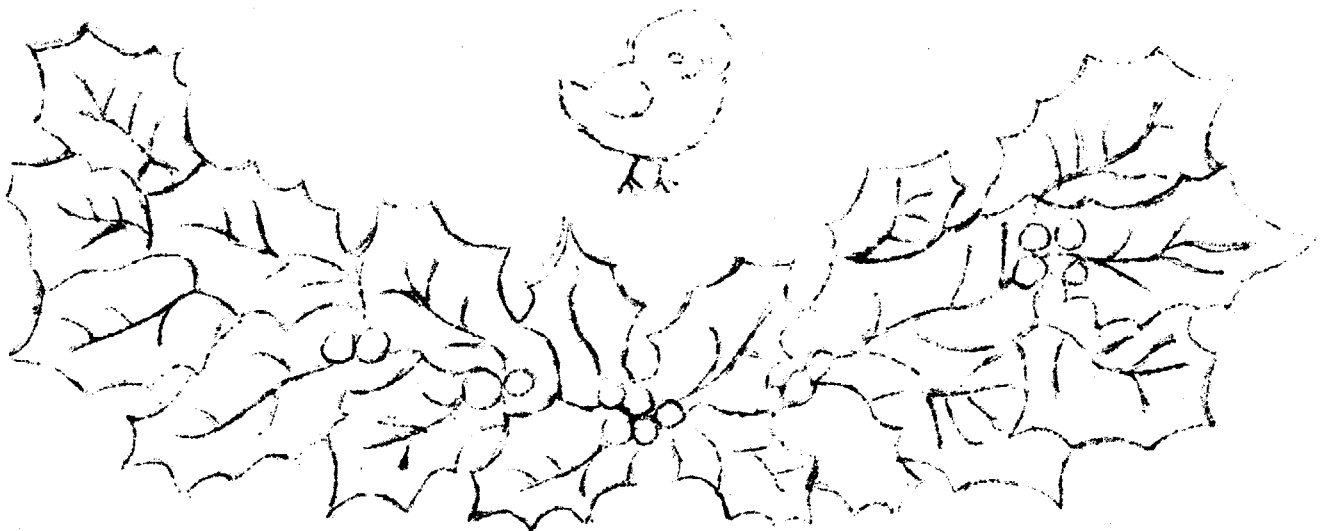
