

In January 2021 Cllr Kevin Hughes died from COVID-19 which left us all very shocked and saddened. That weekend many of us went out to walk a 5km circuit as Kevin had been doing before he fell ill. The Community Council decided to invite Gwernymynydd and Cadole residents and friends to undertake a suggested walk again in October to remember Kevin.



Directions- suggested route

The **suggested** route starts and ends at the Village Centre. There will be directional markers showing the way (see also map overleaf). However feel free to vary it however you want.

From the Village Centre, turn left up the hill, past the line of the Corona Cobra, to Paddock Way.

Turn left following the obvious vehicle track passing in front of a couple of houses.

At the end of the track follow the Twm Path which, shortly after leaving the vehicle track, <u>takes a path to the left of a gate</u>. Stay on the left hand edge when it opens up into a field.

The Twm Path ends at Ffordd Las, a tarmac road. Turn right here, past Bryn Alyn and right again at the next road junction walking up the hill towards and past the Owain Glyndwr Inn.

Keeping the Owain Glyndwr on your right, continue along Ffordd Bryngwyn to Bryngwyn Farm.

Take the public footpath on the left just before the farm buildings which takes you through a paddock and then onto the slopes of Moel Findeg. Follow the way marked signs trending to the right up and up until you reach the summit (364m / 1194ft).

Hopefully you'll be able to enjoy a good view across to Moel Famau and out to the River Dee and Liverpool.

Continue along the Moel Findeg ridge towards a stile and into the nature reserve.

After a metal kissing-gate the path divides. Take the <u>right-hand path</u> continuing downhill until you emerge back onto Ffordd Bryngwyn. Now turn right along the tarmac road for about 1km.

Shortly after passing Bryngwyn Farm there is a public footpath sharp left signposted Gwernymynydd.

Follow this farm track past the old quarry workings on the right. A stile on your left takes you into a field with a clearly marked track towards the woods. Work your way carefully down the steepish path through the woods until you emerge at Llys Enfys.

(Alternatively, to avoid the final steep descent, stay on the road after Bryngwyn Farm and turn left at the Owain Glyndwr Inn to return along Glyndwr Road.)

Back onto the main road and then it's downhill to the Village Centre.
