

HOUGHTON CEMETERY FEES – FROM 1 APRIL 2019

Houghton Cemetery is owned and managed by Houghton and Wyton Parish Council. Any enquiries should be made to the Parish Clerk. The money from fees contributes to the upkeep of the cemetery. The fees do **not include** any services for funeral arrangements, grave digging or religious ceremonies. All excess soil must be removed.

This cemetery is for the sole use of current residents of the Parish of Houghton and Wyton only with the following exceptions:

- The resident has left the Parish solely to reside in a residential care home
- Interment with a husband/wife/partner/child in an existing plot
- In the case of a stillborn child the parent(s) must be current residents
- Where, on the presentation of a written appeal to the PC, exceptional or compelling compassionate grounds are demonstrated

Exclusive Right of Burial can be purchased by a current resident in advance or at the time of arranging the funeral. For an existing grave, ownership must be confirmed as either being the deceased or a living person named on the deed. If this is not the case the ownership must be transferred prior to the interment.
