

MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, MARKERS AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS June 2015

Specification for memorials on a grave in respect of which an Exclusive Right of Burial has been granted. Fees are payable for the erection of headstones and markers and for additional inscriptions. **This is a LAWN Cemetery; stone kerbs are no longer permitted**

HEADSTONE Not exceeding 100cm in height
Not exceeding 60cm wide by 30cm deep

FLAT/WEDGE MARKERS Ashes interred in a ashes plot
Not exceeding 46 x 46cm square

FLAT/WEDGE MARKERS Ashes interred in an existing earthen burial grave
Not exceeding 30 x 30cm wide

VASE or URN Must be removable
Not exceeding 38cm high

OTHER MONUMENTS This is a LAWN cemetery and other monuments should not be placed on graves. Temporary memorials will be tolerated but may be removed by the Parish Clerk after a suitable time. These will be retained for six months to be claimed.

Bushes or Trees are not permitted on graves, but may be considered elsewhere. The Parish Council has a Memorials Policy and Application procedure that applies throughout the Parish. Please contact the Parish Clerk if you need details

PERMITTED HEADSTONE MATERIAL

Preference given to local stone. **White Marble will not be permitted**

The Parish Clerk will approve the material based on Memorial firms' catalogues and what is judged fitting with other headstones in Houghton Cemetery

PERMITTED INSCRIPTION TEXT

Text to be approved by the Parish Clerk prior to inscribing

Pictures will not be permitted
