1. Highland Council Tech Services - Colin Ross SLN Road improvements

- a. Sochi's bends Late in starting work but good progress on wall, laying blocks faster than can be supplied. Planned as of 2nd April to go to traffic management(T Lights), finishing of wall is being looked into (spray on acrylic resin - local stone colour)
 - Flichity Bridge SSE to carry out strengthening work and install passing place on south side of bridge with new lining and signage.
 - Probably finish all the above works June beginning July, sooner if possible.
- b. Torness The road planning gain package and other conditions are still being worked on which must go back to ward members for agreement. No planned road closures whilst Sochi's is on, May request plant on site to meet October grid connection date.
- c. Caolanour Junction SSE to pay for two legs, THC to pay for third, Colin showed the proposed design (proper T junction) CC gave Unanimous support for the design.
- d. Errogie CC supports proposed design, THC to hold Errogie residents meeting to show final draft when ready. Alternative Bat roost must be supplied to replace old house, this to be built into new Bus Shelter roof space.
- e. Corriegarth
 - i. Loch Tarff, barriers, road safety audit to be done to indicate what are needed, THC agreed to get report, compare to guidance and to come back to CC in next couple of months with proposal. Blind Summits are to be double tracked on ridges and tapered back in.
 - ii. Verge and tree clearance, CC to pass comments to RJ MacLeod
 - iii. Monument and other road markings, Center line (double line) to be put in over brow and towards Gorthleck, also a couple of warning signs.
- f. Aberchalder road, Developer can proceed provided junction is improved; THC will inspect present condition of road so left in as good a condition as found.
- g. Misc. Roads, Pot Holes & culvert at Foyers School hill, Trinloist various holes again, Lay-bys with no sign and desire line laybys with big holes.
