1. SFCT Meeting 07 March

The approved minute will be available on the Trust website in about two weeks. Meanwhile, here are some notes.

- Hardship Grant/Knockie Trust: A draft concordat on possible joint action has been produced.
- Metal Detectorist: as of 07 March nothing had happened with regard to the request to scan the Riverside field.
- Stratherrick Film Club: A plan to acquire a new projector and also replace the screen in the Stratherrick hall is being looked at.
- Riverside Field:
 - i) Discussions with HRI (architects) on invoices and access tendering are continuing.
 - ii) Alternative access quotations are also being sought.
 - iii) Quotes for mowing/maintenance to be obtained.
- Broadband: Usage is still growing.
- Summer Event: Various possibilities are being pursued, with a decision to be made soon.
- BCC – Lower Foyers units: There was an overall discussion on a possible lease change. Also, the next (5th of six) grant of £10,000 was approved.
- AOB:
 - i) Foyers bay scrub and tree clearance was discussed.
 - ii) New forms are to be introduced for grant applications.

2. Grants

The next deadline is imminent, following which the usual approval procedure will take place. Grants will be formally agreed at the June SFCT meeting.
