

Yet Another Recipe from:

Drinking on Mars The Martian Book of Drinks

OLYMPUS MONS

A warming winter tippie with Sandstone Tower Liqueur* that provides a glow right down to the toes. A favourite of Martian mining engineers and named for the highest peak on the Red Planet (and the entire Solar System in fact), it makes an elegant cocktail when served in a large glass.

Ingredients

- 45 ml single malt Scotch whisky
- 15 ml lemon juice
- 15 ml pomorange syrup
- 8 ml Sandstone Tower Liqueur*
- Ice cubes
- A float of red wine

Method

- Add all the ingredients except the wine to a cocktail shaker over ice
- Shake and strain the mixture into a cocktail glass
- Carefully float the red wine over the top over the back of a spoon



*Sandstone Tower Liqueur is produced **only** by the Viking Vintners Consortium; its recipe is a closely-guarded secret but is probably related to grapes, vodka and sugar. Sold by retailers everywhere.
