MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON MONDAY 13 JANUARY 2020 AT 7.00PM IN THE WI/VILLAGE HALL

PRESENT: Cllr M D Senior, Chairman of the Council together with C Roe, C Turnbull, S Lynch and Mrs S Glover.

1233. RESIDENTS. present raised a number of matters and where relevant they are listed together with the actions that will be taken, if required. In due course, if necessary, reports will be made back to the Council.

- a) WATER WORKS. It was noted that there had been several issues concerning the Water Works upgrade. Heavy vehicle had been heard travelling down Mill Way at 4am, weekend working is most weekends, the road surface down Mill Way is deteriorating and the spoil heap at the south of the site has increased again. NWL had experienced snags and the end date of the upgrade will be delayed. If cold weather testing cannot take place till after March or April, it will be delayed for a further year in which case the end date will be into 2021. If cold weather testing can take place then the work could be completed by November 2020. With regards to the road surface down Mill Way, NWL will approach NCC to see if they could authorise NWL to carry out the resurfacing of the road.
- **b) TREE PLANTING.** A successful tree planting day had taken place at The Hearth. Tom Martin is to provide a cost for tree maintenance at the east end of the village.
- c) DOG FOULING. It was noted that the dog bin on the post at the west end of the village had fallen over. This had been reported to NCC at the beginning of December however it had still not been replaced. Unfortunately, dog walkers had been placing dog poo bags on the verge beside the bin. These had been removed from Maurice and he was thanked for doing this. Signs were requested for the farm gate on Water Lane. This will be arranged.
