Church Hall -

The chairman mentioned the Parochial Church Council (PCC) had approached the Parish Council with an offer to create a lease for the Church Hall to enable this to be operated and managed by the parish. The Parish Council is currently discussing the proposed arrangement with the PCC. The Hall would remain available as a community space for meetings, other activities in the Hall would be subject to any existing covenants, which would be investigated.

**Grant Application -**

Mr Ian Smith spoke about an application for grant funding submitted to enable works to refurbish the Church Hall and of the need to establish a steering committee should the application be successful. The grant money would not be allocated for specific works but would be available for the overall refurbishment of the Hall.

Cadeby Hall Proposed Development -
