The Hamlet of Plumtree has known historical associations back to at least the Saxon period of British history.

A Plumtree or Plumtre or even Plumbtree family are said to have originated here, one of whom figured in a law suit in the time of King Edward the First.

Village life was centred around the Church, which is possibly the oldest Church in the County and has a copy of the painting of "The Descent from the Cross" by Rubens, which is in Antwerp Cathedral. At the restoration of the Church some of the stone work from the old Trent Bridge was used.

Since 1894, Plumtree has been a rural parish with its affairs conducted at Parish Meetings. The Rushcliffe Borough Council, at the request of the Parish Meeting, made an Order constituting a Parish Council of Plumtree, which has seven Councillors. The election of the Councillors took place on the 5th May, 1977.

This is the first Parish Council to be instituted in the Borough of Rushcliffe since reorganisation of local government.

His Worship the Mayor of the Borough Council, Councillor H. H. Sanders, JP., FIB., FSBI., took the Chair for the election of the Chairman of the Parish Council.
