One Year On

You may recall the first picture from an early issue of the Newsletter. It was taken just over a year ago as Tom Gillot cut the first sod to start the building of the new shop for Creaton. Here we are twelve months later and what a change!

The groundworks started after Easter and the building arrived on the back of a lorry in May. After completion and fitting out, Creaton Village Shop opened its doors on Saturday 25th August.

Since then, it has become a popular shop, not just for its good looks but also for what it sells. It stocks a number of local foods, fresh meat, fresh cakes, and fresh bread; a range of gluten-free products and all the things you might need to fill that gap in your store cupboard.

Got some spare time? Become a volunteer!

Would you like to be part of Creaton Village Shop? This is a community enterprise and we are always looking for volunteers to serve behind the counter and help to keep the shop running smoothly.

Our shifts are two hours long, though if it suits you, you can work double shifts, always on days to suit you. If ad hoc is best for you, that's fine, and you are not committed to working the same shift every week. The system is very flexible, and we like to fit in with your routine as we know everyone is busy.

We have young helpers at weekends and from 5pm till 6.30 on weekdays, who are aged 14 years and upwards. Our upper age limit is 120.

The job entails: serving behind the counter for the shop – i.e. not serving Post Office customers, but helping store customers with their groceries, keeping shelves stocked, checking dates on produce, light cleaning duties, and being cheerful, friendly and helpful.
