New roof...

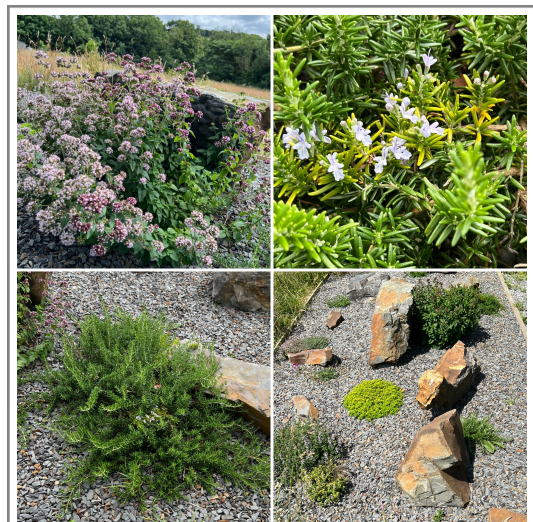
