PREVIOUS MINUTES

231/19 The Council unanimously resolved to adopt the draft minutes from the Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting held on 3rd August 2019 with no amendments made.

BOROUGH AND COUNTY COUNCILLOR REPORTS

DRAFT BUDGET

233/19 The Council discussed the draft budget for 2020 – 2021 including sourcing funding for the two proposed defibrillators and adding in a budget item for Dadlington Neighbourhood Plan. New proposed budget items include a separate item for publicity and a tree survey for 2020.

SHENTON WAR MEMORIAL

234/19 The Clerk gave an update on the renovation of Shenton War Memorial and how some issues regarding the cleaning of the memorial has occurred. Work is now focused on completing the project and seeking the funding from LCC. A final phase of the project may include highlighting the lettering with black enamel with further match funding from LCC.
