

Q1 What are the most important issues for the Neighbourhood Plan? (Please rank as many as you can in order of importance where 1 is the most important)




Q2 Do you agree that the countryside around Dadlington should be protected for the sake of its intrinsic character, beauty, heritage and wildlife?





Q3 How do you use the countryside around Dadlington? (please select all those that apply)









Q7 Do you support the creation of a pedestrian, horse riding and cycle route along the former Ashby and Nuneaton Joint Railway?





Q8 What are the most important priorities for habitat improvement in the area? (Please rank as many as you can in order of importance where 1 is the most important)







Q13 Do you think that any infill or additional housing should be consistent with and sympathetic to the to the existing character of the village?





Q14 Do you think that our Neighbourhood Plan should include guidance on the design of new buildings?





Q15 Should the Neighbourhood Plan be used to protect these services and facilities?








Q18 Which of the following measures would you support to help reduce vehicle speeds?



Q19 Is inconsiderate parking a problem in the village?











Q23 Do you think that the Settlement Boundary has been a good way of controlling development in Dadlington?





Q24 Do you agree with the current Dadlington Settlement Boundary?





Q25 Outside Dadlington Settlement Boundary, which of the following types of housing development would you support?







Q27 Does your household, or anyone in your household, anticipate the need to find a new home in Dadlington within the next ten years?





Q28 How many people of each age group are there in the household that expects to move?









Q31 When would the household expect to need to move?



















Q46 Do you require additional business space in the next three years?








