Net Zero consultation:

Recently we launched a major consultation on our ambitions to make Leicestershire a net zero carbon county by 2045 earlier this month and addressed the topic at the recent meeting of the Environment & Climate Change Committee.

New Census Data

New census data shows Leicestershire growing, with new population figures available by sex and age group.

The overall population of Leicestershire has risen from 650,489 in the 2011 national census to 712,300 in the 2021 census.

Queens Award for Voluntary Service:

The Queens award for voluntary service is the highest award given to volunteer groups across the UK.

At Full Council this week an appeal was made from the Leicestershire Lieutenancy Office for any voluntary actions to be put forward for consideration.

To be nominated, a group must:

- be made up of at least 3 people
- be led by volunteers, not paid staff
- have been running for at least 3 years
- be based in the UK, Channel Islands or Isle of Man
- provide a specific and direct benefit to their local communities
