145/18 The Council resolved to adopt the draft minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 14th November with no amendments.

SPEED INDICATOR REVIEW

- Following issues with the battery powered vehicle activated sign (VAS) in the Parish, the following actions were voted on and unanimously agreed by the Council:
- To purchase 3 new battery powered VAS that will be permanently sited in each village. The new VAS in Dadlington and Sutton Cheney will indicate speed, with a warning to slow down if over the speed limit and a thank you if under the speed limit. The new VAS in Shenton will simply say "slow down" if exceeding the speed limit and will require the installation of a new pole to attach it to. The preferred location in Shenton was near the aquaduct near to the park gate. All 3 signs will collect speed data that can be used as evidence for further speed enforcement work. The Clerk will contact the principle landowner of Shenton as well as contact LCC Highways and the planning authority to check permissions.
