BOROUGH AND COUNTY COUNCILLOR REPORTS

The Council noted the report from Borough Councillor Jonathon Collett who gave an update on a variety of planning issues pertinent to the Parish, including an update on the pre-submission received from developers on the area of separation between Stoke Golding and Dadlington.

Problems with broadband speeds is not as fast as what was promised by LCC and Cllr Collett will be contacting them to see what can be done. Public consultation on the Local Plan will be until 27th August.
