182/22 | COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE REVIEW

Four councillors in favour and one against: that the name of a parish council that does not separate should be 'Dadlington, Sutton Cheney, and Shenton Parish Council'.

Four in favour and two against with one abstention: that Dadlington should only have three seats, not four as proposed.

Five councillors in favour and two against: noting that the Parish Council is divided on this matter but also noting that petitions have been submitted to HBBC by residents in favour of two separate parish councils.

Four councillors in favour and three against: that the parish council should separate into one council for Dadlington and one for Shenton and Sutton Cheney.
