



Recommendations for Emergencies

Ensure you have batteries and a working or wind up torch in an easily accessible place.

Have your mobile phone fully charged when you expect bad weather, as cordless telephones will not work in a power cut. Consider a back up plug in phone.

- Battery or windup radio
- Solar or battery lantern
- Candles, holder and matches
- Thermos flask
- Hot water bottle
- A camping stove
- Fire extinguisher
- Salt for footpaths and a shovel
- Some tinned and UHT products
- De-icer or scraper for car

Don't travel unless absolutely necessary.

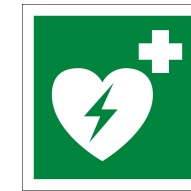
Watch out for slippery paths and pavements.

Don't forget elderly neighbours.



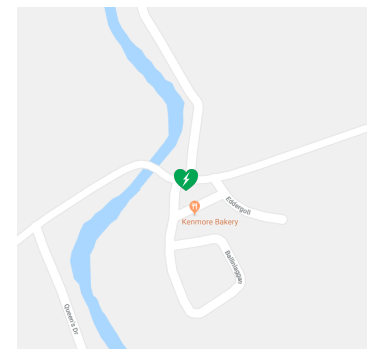
Automated Defibrillators can be located in the location below.

Always dial 999 first



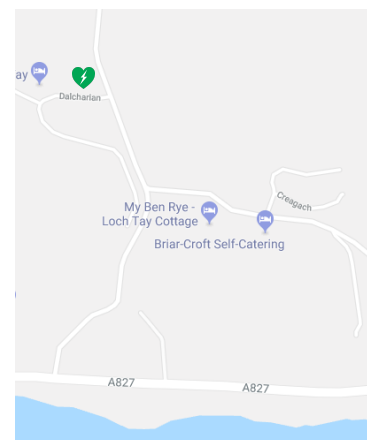
Kenmore
