CANN (Collaborative Action for Natura Network)



Act is one of the 11 strong Collaborative Action for Natura Network group which has successfully bid for European funding over 5 years for a programme of peatland restoration on Islay. CANN will bring employment and contract opportunities to Islay and will look at conservation action plans including the management of Rhododendron ponticum in priority areas.
