

## Appendix 2: Secretary's Report for the period June 2017 to April 2018.

The following table shows the attendance at the AGM, held in June 2017 and at the six ordinary meetings held in June, August, October, December 2017, and February and April 2018.

- The number of members of the Council was 15
- The average attendance of elected members was 63%.
- Fewer members of the public attended than in the past three years.
- Our guests at the April meeting were two A&B employees from the Supporting Communities Fund.
