

#### Item 4: Secretary's Report for the period June 2024 to June 2025.

- The last AGM was on 12th June 2024. We have held 6 regular meetings.
- Membership in June 2024 was 14. One member was co-opted in October 2024 and another in April 2025 but three members resigned in February making a total of 13 including the two co-optees. The next election will be in 2026. Our maximum membership is 16.
- Police Scotland provided a Crime Report for all meetings.
- The Representative of the HMNB Clyde, Cmdr Jon Fletcher joined the Community Council in August 2024 and attended four of the meetings, and provided a report to two others. The community is once again very grateful to the base for the provision of the Christmas tree for the village green.
- Our three Councillors were represented by Cllr Corryat three of our meetings.
- We had a visit from Meja Vesterlund from the Scottish Wildlife Trust in October 2024. Our area is borderline for the re-colonisation of red squirrels if the greys can be controlled. We publicised this in our Newsletter.
- The June, August and October meetings were held in the Community Centre. In order not to inconvenience the Nursery, the December, February and April meetings were held in the Church Hall.
