a: Rhu (Ardenconnel) Playing Fields.

The formal Planning Permission has been submitted and is now subject to due process, the results of which are awaited.

b: The Armed Forces Community Covenant.

The latest set of (6) bids have been received and were due to have been assessed on Fri 29 Jan 16.

c: The MOD Education Support Fund.

As reported in the local press, in addition to other separate awards, a total of £118,680 has been awarded to schools in the Helensburgh area from this fund. It was established to help make the transition for the children of Service families easier but inevitably it also provides a beneficial impact upon other pupils.

d: Major Naval Exercises.
