

# Taking care of your sewer network in Rhu - Overview

- This Project is required to upgrade the existing sewer network in Rhu to help enhance water quality in the Firth of Clyde.
  - This is part of an **£5m** investment in the sewer network across the Firth of Clyde over the next 12 months in Rhu, Kilmun, Strone, Innellan and Toward.
