Jean, just to update you on where we are in respect of the archaeology. Scottish Woodlands were out to look at the site yesterday and are getting professional archaeologist advice (not from the same firm that produced the original report). One of my team is out looking at the site tomorrow.

In relation to breeding birds, Scottish Woodlands are aware of the potential constraints here in terms of operations and again have been taking professional advice and are in discussion with Scottish Forestry on that.

Separately, in relation to the section of forest road that has been built, we have asked Scottish Woodlands/Gresham House to carry out some improvement works on that following a joint inspection we made. Any further road building work is currently suspended.

I'll update you further, certainly by early next week.
