In each occasion I contacted Aberdeenshire Council to get resolution to the issue which seems to be the inability for the drains in the street to clear when heavy downpours

occur. Not once has anyone from Aberdeenshire Council replied or contacted me regarding this issue and with possible solutions, I have had to bear the costs of clean up each time and I see no reason why I should since this issue is clearly a problem with the road and drainage. I am reaching out to you to ask for some assistance in getting some resolution to this issue from Aberdeenshire Council as it appears with weather changes this is becoming a more regular occurrence and I simply cannot accept this happening again. I hope that one or even better all of you can recognize the plight I am in here, I have a partner who is concerned everytime it rains especially if we are away from the property and we are simply looking for a resolution. Please can you take time to highlight this issue to the correct person as I seem to have no voice when contacting Aberdeenshire Council?

7/9/22 Thank you for your prompt reply, Hunter Drive has been known about by Aberdeenshire Council for some time now, it is exacerbated by the fact that there are water pumps installed in the street to assist with the clearing of water from the gullies. I am looking to get answers from Aberdeenshire Council as to what they intend doing to prevent this event happening again to my property, this is purely happening due to a build up of water in the street reaching a level (over a foot) where it then floods into my land. In addition because the waste water (shower, washing machine etc) in these house is tied into the same drainage the remnants of this come up through the drain on my property as the water is being back up from the street, this is an environmental health issue as well. I look forward to hearing back from you regards what Aberdeenshire Council intend to do to rectify this matter, to date I keep get given case numbers (696687 being the latest) and then not hearing a peep!
