Cllr DR explained SFP intended as a safety/public health measure. Is temporary and could be eased but should remain until crisis over

RC some are dangerously positioned outside Nickel and Dime/Cllr DR It is being dealt with

MD Businesses are concerned by threat to their business

Cllr WA Could have done other things with this money/not happy with them. Officers decided this not councillors. Cllr SD Cones signalled change

MD Other towns look better eg Inverurie

Cllr DR Other areas needed new ones. Cones were here but other areas needed new purchase/is worried businesses may close/whether parking is available

Discussion of why people aren't shopping

AL Many elderly and infirm can't get parked and are afraid to walk down

Cllr SD See what review brings

PC suggested extension to blue badge giving priority to them in the Square

JS spoke of getting employees to park elsewhere
