Finance

(a) Annual Governance Statement Approval

Defibrillator

Cllr. Wykes had made enquires at his place of work regarding the availability of a surplus unit. Unfortunately there were none available.

Cllr. Wykes confirmed that the modern units were powered by a standard battery which would make replacement batteries cheaper. Cllr. Newsam asked him to obtain a price for this newer model.

Cllr. Newsam confirmed that there was the possibility of some lottery funding but this could not be pursued until the bank details had been updated.

Emergency Plan

Cllr. Newsam confirmed that he had received a communication from East Riding Council stating that they had no record of Skeffling having an Emergency Plan. The have sent a template plan for our Parish.

This was discussed at length and it was agreed to treat it as a working document, allowing Councillors to provide input for future meetings as to what should be included in the plan additional to the standard information.
