Precept 2023/24- Following all the work on the Old Ford Project and considering the future projects the council need to undertake, the Colwinston council have voted to increase their precept by 18%. **Resolved:** That the precept be set at £17,912.00 for the year 2023/24. This will result in a Band D Property of £47.77 which should produce a precept amounting to £17,912.00 (i.e. £47.77 x £375 VOG £1 Levy)
