Minutes of the Meeting held on the 16th October 2019 @ 7:30 p.m. Fernaig House

1 Present and Apologies

3 Chairman's report

We continued work on the new relays this month and marked the 40th man day of effort spent on Creag Mhaol and the raised beach. However the weather has ensured that most of the trips to the top of Crag Mhaol were less than the full hours expected as it is rare that work isn't interrupted by rain or gales (or both). Many more days have been spent at sea level preparing and testing equipment so it can be transported and installed at the top of the hill.

This week we discovered that all the marker posts which we had installed to show the route of the cable runs had been removed.

Replacing 700 metres of marker posts will waste a considerable amount of time and delay other work.

3.1 Bandwidth

At the moment capacity is holding up well. Since the last minutes there have been a handful of times when we have crept over the 65 Mbps threshold. We will continue to monitor the situation. **Action: Phil**

On the 14th & 15th of October power was turned off at Plockton High School for planned maintenance which meant we lost our internet connection. We were not informed that the power would be turned off. Once we had traced the cause of the fault we redirected traffic through the Lochcarron backup line. Although the backup line has less than half the capacity of Plockton we were able to remain connected to the internet until power was restored at the school. We will contact the school to obtain new contact phone numbers as we received no response on the numbers we had been given and only discovered what was going on by driving over to Plockton. Action: Phil

3.2 Firmware / False RADAR

As there had been no incidents of false RADAR since the beginning of September it was decided to upgrade the remainder of the units to the latest firmware. Two days after this change there were three false RADAR events logged by the Braeintra access point. Even though the Braeintra access point and subscribers equipment had been updated to the latest firmware a week earlier without incident.

Quite why Braeintra is seeing incidents of false RADAR remains a mystery at the moment. We will continue to monitor the system. **Action: Phil**

3.3 New Backhaul Installation in Achmore Hall

3.3.1 Get quote for installation

Mary has spoken to Zen who says that they cannot get a quote from Openreach as the Hall address is not registered on the Post Office database. Mary agreed with Martin Irving (chairman of the hall committee) that she will register the hall's address and has completed the Post Office forms and is waiting for a response.

Zen informed us that the installation could be anything between two weeks and several months and we will not know how long it takes until a firm order is placed with Openreach via Zen.

As we are concentrating all our efforts of getting the new Creag Mhaol relays up and running we won't be ready to use the line in a couple of weeks however we cannot afford to put off our order until we are ready and then find we are faced with a delay of several months.

There was some discussion about the best way to proceed and it was decided we would place an order with Zen once we have confirmation of the post office registration and have installed our cabinet inside the hall so the Openreach socket can be installed. If it turns out the installation will be two weeks we will then decide whether to cancel the order (and lose some unrefundable payments) or continue with the order and leave the line dormant until we can complete the work to add the new Achmore line to CMNet. In that case we will be paying some rental charges for a line that we cannot use.

Mary will talk to Zen to clarify our options to cancel and order and then reorder in a few months time. **Action:**Mary

We have had a request for a connection in Lochcarron; once our existing commitments have been met we will see if this is feasible.

There was some debate as to what we should charge subscribers who change their minds and decide to join having previously not taken up the option whilst the CBS grant was available. It was decided we should charge 89% of the cost of the equipment which is the equivalent of the contribution from CBS. This will be collected at £12 a month for the first year in addition to the New Joiners Premium making the total surcharge £20 per month for the first year.

The configuration of the remaining equipment for Creag Mhaol Strome side relays has been completed.

Using generator power the link from CMS_High to the raised beach has been tested and the signal strength will need to be improved

The units for CMS_High have been delivered to the relay but cannot be installed until the problems with the raised beach have been resolved.

The units on CMS Low have been installed and are waiting to be cabled up and tested.

Two reels of trunking have been taken to CMAHigh ready to cover the cable to CMA_Intermediate.

Using generator power test the units on CMS_Low

Using generator power test the links between CMS_High, CMS_Low and the Portchullin raised beach

Encase the power cable from CMA_Intermediate to CMA_High in trunking

Take a reel of trunking to CMA Intermediate ready to cover the cable to CMA Low.

Encase the power cable from CMA_Intermediate to CMA_Low in trunking

Replace the CMA_High router enclosure

Test the mains power supply to the new relays

Replace the CMA_Low router enclosure

Test the new relay automated recovery algorithms

Install test equipment in Ardaneaskan East

Test the beam width of the Portchullin Access Point

Waste time replacing 700 metres of marker posts that have been removed

8.3.4 The Glen

One access point will be upgraded to see if that will reduce the noise levels. No progress this month. **Action:** Phil

The Portchullin and Ardaneaskan East access points and backbone link to Creag Mhaol have been installed at the Portchullin raised beach relay. Activation of the Portchullin relay is waiting on the activation of the new Creag Mhaol relays. Action: Phil

The line of sight to the new North Strome relay has been confirmed. Activation of the North Strome relay is waiting on the activation of the new Creag Mhaol relays. **Action: Phil**

We have surveyed various locations for a relay to provide an access point for Reraig. Access will almost certainly require a much higher relay than we have built so far. We will return to the relay investigation and build once the current relays are active. **Action: Phil**
