1. **To consider accepting** the reasons for any apologies for absence.
2. **Declarations of interest** in items on the agenda. Members are no longer required to declare personal or prejudicial interests but are to declare any new Disclosable Pecuniary Interests or Other Interests that are not currently included in the Register of Interests. Members are reminded that under the Code of Conduct they are not to participate in the whole of an agenda item in which they have an Interest. In the interests of transparency, Members may also wish to declare any other interests they have in relation to an agenda item, in support of the seven Nolan Principles, namely Selflessness, Integrity, Objectivity, Accountability, Openness, Honesty and Leadership.

[6.1] **Community Speedwatch.** The Chairman of Caston Parish Council says that they have a new Speedwatch co-ordinator who has recruited a larger volunteer team, but wants to allow time for the teams and schedules to bed in before considering the possibility of a joint operation, and so has suggested a review in six months time. As yet there have been no additional volunteers to join a Stow Bedon & Breckles group.

Firstly, he suggests that the three parishes in his Division through which the road passes (Wretham, Hockham and Stow Bedon & Breckles) should consider making a joint application under the Parish Partnership Scheme to obtain a Vehicle Activated Sign which could be positioned in a number of locations along the road, designed to encourage drivers to moderate their speed.
11. **To consider** a request from Caston Parish Council for support in their attempts to get a review of road safety issues on Stow Bedon Road in the area of Rayner's Falgate.
12. **To receive** notice from Historic England that it is considering the Stow Bedon War Memorial t the List of Buildings of Special Architectural or Historic Interest, and to consider any further information or observations on its initial assessment report which the Council may like to make.
