Minutes of a Meeting of Stow Bedon & Breckles Parish Council on Monday, 13 July 2020 at 6.00 p.m. This was a virtual on-line meeting.

- **Apologies for absence**. It was **resolved** to accept the reason for absence offered by Cllr. Howe. 1 The Chairman said he would like to remind all members that the Council needs to agree that the reason for an absence is acceptable if a member is to be able avoid "the six-month rule" in the Local Government Act 1972's. 85(1) which states, "... if a member of a local authority fails throughout a period of six consecutive months from the date of his last attendance to attend any meeting of the authority, he shall, unless the failure was due to some reason approved by the authority before the expiry of that period, cease to be a member of the authority." If no apology and reason is submitted before a meeting the Council is, therefore, unable to do anything, and eventually a member will just cease to be a member, and a Casual Vacancy will occur. So he encouraged members to advise the Clerk if they are not going to be able to attend a meeting, and to give the reason. This reason will only be revealed to other members to avoid matters like extended absence from home being made public.

It was resolved that the Council objected because the existing barn has a footprint of 486 sgm., which exceeds the 465 sgm limit required for Permitted Development, and also on grounds of poor design, future development of the site, reliance on private cars, and similar issues.
