STOW BEDON & BRECKLES PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of a Meeting of Stow Bedon & Breckles Parish Council on Wednesday, 16 December 2020 at 7.30 p.m. This was a Zoom on-line meeting.

Present: Councillors: Dawn Jessett (Vice-Chairman), Phil Childs, Lee Pilkington, Hannah Reed, Julian Gibson (Clerk)

In the absence of the Council Chairman, the Vice-Chairman took the Chair.

- **1 Apologies for absence**. It was **resolved** to accept the reasons for absence offered by Cllr. Morfoot and Cllr. White
- 2 Declarations of interest. None.
- 3 Dispensations. None.
- 4 Public participation session.
 - 4.1 Jane Freemen, the applicant for application 3PL/2020/11237/F (Agenda item 8.1) introduced the application and explained that she was the executor and trustee for the previous deceased owner, who had left the residual estate to three charities (Parents and Children Together, The Howk and Owl Trust, and Spaniel Aid). Therefore, she had an obligation to maximise the value of the land, and clearly obtaining planning permission for the development of the barn would help to achieve that. During the discussion it was pointed out that the Planning Application site appeared to be less that the land held by her in trust, and she agreed to look into this.
 - 4.2 District Councillor Phil Cowen said that he had been in contact with NCC Cllr. Fabian Eagle concerning the damage being caused to Mere Road by the decision to close Cherry Tree Lane to put in passing places at the same time as construction of the development for which they were required. The Council asked to Clerk to write to both NCC Highways and Breckland Planning about the matter. Cllr. Cowen added that in view of the interest, he had requested that Application 3PL/2020/1237/F be called in for determination, but did not yet know whether that he been accepted.

 - 6.1 [2] **Casual Vacancy**. Breckland Council Electoral Services has confirmed that no requests for an election were received, and that as a result the Council can proceed to fill the vacancy by co-option, to take place as soon as practicable.
 - 6.2 [15 minutes of 15 October 2020] **Telephone kiosk redecoration**. The Clerk has at last managed to obtain the free paint (gloss and undercoat) for the kiosk, and has emailed CDC Decorating Services (Clive Cole) to ask when work can start.

 - 8.1 **3PL/2020/1237/F: East Barn, Mere Farm, Stow Bedon Road, Stow Bedon**. Change of use of an agricultural building to 2 no. dwellinghouses, with integral garage. It was **resolved** that the Council objected on the grounds that it was directly in contravention of three requirements of Policy HOU05.

- **Precept 2021/22**. It was **agreed** to fix the Precept for 2021/22 at £5,150, an increase of £150. However, as the number of Band D equivalents has risen (meaning that the precept is spread across more payers) there will be only minimal change to the parish council part of residents' Council Tax bills.
