The shooting rights are let to Jonathan Yule of Stow Bedon for another 5 years. Jonathan's 5 year contact will last March 31st 2022.

During 2006/17 period the Charity had an income of £1288.57 and expenditure was £1513.00

During the last year 3 households have received fuel grants of £400 each. As a reminder the Trustees reviewed the Charities Governing Document in 2007 the revised objects of the charity from the beneficiaries account is to.

- To make grants to the poor and needy of the Parish of Stow Bedon and Breckles By;
- To make grants for Fuel
- To make grants for Mobility Devices
- To make grants for the Relief of Distress
- To make grants for Further Education

During 2016 the site benefited from Habitat Management advise and a survey has been carried out which identified the site containing 24 species of conservation concern. The survey was carried out with a grant from the Freshwater Habitats Trust's "Flagship Ponds Project"

The Charity is now in the process of applying for a Environmental Stewardship Grant with English Nature and it is hoped that the new agreement will start in January 2018.

Prices are now being obtained to fence the boundary between the Fuel Allotment and the Pingo Trail footpath, it is hoped that the work will be carried out during the winter 2017/2018
