2. Structure, governance and management.

- 2.1. Governing document: Conveyance dated 20 September 1952 as amended by Scheme sealed 14 February 1985.
- 2.2. Appointment of Trustees: The Trustee is Stow Bedon and Breckles Parish Council, consisting of up to seven members, elected every four years.

3. Financial Review.

- 3.1. The Charity's reserves are invested and the income used to further the charity objectives.
- 3.2. Investments:
 - 3.2.1. St James's Place Wealth Management Unit Trusts valued as at 31 March 2021 at £25,568.
 - 3.2.2. Barclays Bank Plc as at 31 March 2021:
 - 3.2.2.1. Community Account: £11.39;
 - 3.2.2.2. Active Saver Account: £689.81.

4. No funds are held as custodian trustee.

5. The Trustees have complied with their duty to have due regard to the guidance on public benefit published by the Commission in exercising their powers or duties.

6. **Objectives and activities:** Any charitable purposes for which provision is not made out of public funds, for the general benefit of the inhabitants of the parishes of Stow Bedon & Breckles, Caston and Hockham.

7. **Achievements and performance:**

7.1. The Trustee is retaining a small surplus in the Charity's Barclays Active Saver account, so it can make small grants without needing to make a withdrawal from the St James's Place Wealth Management investment.

7.2. In view of the global Covid-19 pandemic, there has been no activity this year except for a small interest payment by Barclays Bank.
