Grab Bag:

In an emergency you may need to move quickly. It is useful to have essential items to hand, ideally kept in an easy to carry bag somewhere accessible.

- □ Spare warm clothes and blankets
- □ Toiletries and sanitary supplies

- $\hfill\square$ Radio and spare batteries or wind-up radio
- □ List of useful numbers or this Emergency Plan
- $\hfill\square$ Spare house and car keys
- □ Notepad and pencil
- □ Black bags/bin liners
- □ Special items for babies, elderly or disabled people
- $\hfill\square$ Bottled water, energy bars, tinned food & tin opener
- $\hfill\square$ Pet carrier, collar, lead and pet food
