 - b. Additional Dog Litter Bins: residents have asked the Council to consider paying for the installation of, and regular collection from, a dog bin near the entrance to the Jurassic Way at Honey Hill. A formal resolution will be needed to approve the expenditure.
 - c. Travellers: Following recent events at the Golf Centre, Members are asked to consider what precautionary measures (e.g. by identifying potential sites and alerting owners) might be taken to forestall further uninvited traveller encampments.
 - **d. Meeting with MP and other parties.** The chairman has arranged to meet Chris Heaton-Harris MP and other parties on the afternoon of Friday 8th October in Cold Ashby.
