Health and safety concerns:

Fire concerns raised by Fire officer (John Callaghan)

- Outside fire door by kitchen needs repairing asap (has to be used with force and needs to open freely)
- Electric heater box.... (sometimes sparks and heaters should be turned off with a switch not a fuse box)
- Fire doors in centre need to be kept clear at all time and signs and tape needs to be used to remind people

Other H and S concerns

• Floors in toilet area are very slippery when hall is in use...solution needs to be found to make them less slippery- wet floors signs also need to be purchased.

- New doors on bar and through to kitchen needed as sliders come off and are not secure
- Need a first aid kit

Cleaning
